



## **CMAA SOCAL 2010 AWARDS GALA AT LALIVE**

On the evening of May 6<sup>th</sup> CMAA SoCal Chapter held its 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Awards Banquet at the new LA Live JW Marriott venue in downtown Los Angeles. Over 730 industry representatives attended, a record number, including our prestigious Owner Honorees and Project Achievement Award winners.
