For immediate release to all CMAA Southern California members: SB 355 has been defeated!

Senator Margett author of SB 355, has decided that he will not be pursuing this bill. His decision was based in great part on the strong opposition he faced by CMAA in California. SB 355, if passed, would have permitted only licensed contractors to practice construction management on any construction project, public or private in the state. This bill proposed to exclude individuals and companies, who are the most qualified to perform construction management, from practicing this specialty. Thanks to the efforts of the boards and members of CMAA San Diego, Northern and Southern California Chapters and our National Organization, this bill has been defeated!
