State College Grade Separation Job Walk

The City of Fullerton and the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) are constructing a vehicle undercrossing at the intersection of State College Boulevard and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway. The roadway will be lowered between Santa Fe Avenue to approximately 500 feet south of Valencia Drive. When completed, the project will move cars safely and smoothly under the railroad tracks, enhancing safety and boosting mobility.
