If Ballot Measure AA Passes:

- THESE PROJECTS WILL BE BUILT:**
 - A lane will be added in each direction to the 101
 - A lane will be added in each direction to the 118 where bottlenecks now exist.
- LOCAL ROADS WILL BE IMPROVED.** About half the money will be spent on the city streets and major arteries that you drive most often.
- TRANSIT OPTIONS WILL INCREASE.** There will be more opportunities for commuters, students and seniors who use our buses and trains.
- IMPROVED BIKE SAFETY.** We will make major strides toward "complete streets" for cyclists.
- THE ECONOMY AT THE PORT WILL IMPROVE.** Better roads in and out of the Port of Hueneme will attract and keep port and transportation industries, increase local jobs and add to our local economy.
- YOUR MONEY STAYS HERE.** The transportation measure raises critically needed funding for transportation projects and programs in Ventura County and will be spent here. It cannot go to Sacramento or Washington, DC, to be used for other purposes. These funds will also go a long way to leverage federal and state transportation funds so that we can build these major freeway projects, build bridges and improve transit service. Lastly, with a local investment commitment, Ventura County will not lose out to Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and other southern California counties who are walking away with our tax payer dollars because Ventura County did not have its local match.
- LOCAL CITIZENS REVIEW THE SPENDING.** There will be a citizens oversight committee that ensures every penny raised locally by this sales tax is spent locally in Ventura County.
