The purpose of the CMAA Southern California Chapter Scholarship Awards is to recognize and promote students who represent the future of the Construction Management industry. Students applying for scholarship awards must demonstrate a genuine interest in pursuing Construction Management as a profession through their studies, letters of reference, and personal statements. In addition, the top two selected Southern California Chapter scholarship recipients (who have completed a minimum of one-full academic year of studies, and have a minimum of one-full academic year remaining prior to completing the degree being pursued) will be notified by the Scholarship Committee for their eligibility to apply for the CMAA Foundation National Scholarship Awards by submitting a national application available through the website at www.CMAAFoundation.org.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Accepted to or enrolled in a degree program pursuing a Bachelors or Masters Degree with a curriculum focus/major in Construction Management or a related discipline in the Southern California Region;
2. Undergraduate applicant must have full-time enrollment and part time graduate applicant must be enrolled in 6 graduate credit for the 2011-2012 academic year
3. Only Two (2) Applicants from each eligible academic institution are permitted to submit applications based on the academic institution professor's recommendation;
4. Applicants must be an active CMAA National Student Member;

Note: *Applicants who are members of a CMAA Southern California Region Campus Chapter are eligible for awards in all values. Applicants who are not members of a CMAA Southern California Region Campus Chapter are only eligible for CMAA SC awards and are excluded from national foundation consideration.*

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items are physically received by the CMAA Southern California Chapter Scholarship Chair on or before **March 23, 2012**:
 - a) Completed and signed application (including proof of enrollment);
 - b) Letter from each institution recommending the applicant out of a total of two applicants per institution (must be attached);
 - c) Official transcript (must be submitted directly from the institution); Either hardcopy by mail or official electronic version by email is acceptable, as long as it is clearly transmitted directly from the institution and not from the applicant; Freshman to include High School transcripts; First-year Graduate students to include undergraduate transcripts.
 - d) Proof of CMAA National Student Membership; and
2. Applications must be submitted in hardcopy/original format. E-mail submissions will not be considered.
3. Applications will be reviewed and interviews will be conducted. Winners will be selected by a CMAA Southern California Chapter's Scholarship Committee.
4. Consideration will be given to those applicants who express an interest in pursuing Construction Management as a profession.
5. Winner(s) will be notified by mail, e-mail, or phone by April 20, 2012.
6. Award(s) will be announced and checks distributed at the CMAA Southern California Chapter Annual Awards Banquet on May 10, 2012, in Los Angeles, California. Recipient's attendance is encouraged, but not mandatory.

AWARDS

The Scholarship Committee's evaluations will be used to determine the appropriate amount of each award based on the applicant's scholastic merit, interviews, and continued interest in the pursuit of Construction Management as a profession.

CMAA Scholarship Awards will be granted without discrimination or harassment of any person on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, physical or mental disability, medical condition (cancer-related or genetic characteristics), ancestry, marital status, age, sexual orientation, or citizenship.
