PROGRAM SUMMARY

After the passage of Proposition 51 in 2016, Long Beach Community College District (LBCCD) was awarded the first-ever State-funded Design-Build project because of the California Community College Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) recommendation to the Governor's Office. The scope of work for this project required the demolition of two existing buildings, built in 1935, and replacing them with a newly constructed 95,000 SF building to provide classrooms, computer labs, a technology center, faculty offices, and support areas for general education instruction. This workshop will detail how the CCCCO, LBCCD, Cordoba Corporation, and the Design Build Team successfully delivered the project. In addition, panelists will summarize the RFQ, RFP, award, and funding approval process for the Design-Build delivery method as well as review in detail the process, benefits, and lessons learned throughout the project.
